Rise Against Hunger is driven by the vision of a world without hunger. Our mission is to end hunger in our lifetime by providing food and life-changing aid to the world's most vulnerable and creating a global commitment to mobilise the necessary resources.

## OUR HISTORY

In 1998, envisioning a world without hunger, Ray Buchanan—a United Methodist minister—founded Stop Hunger Now. In 2017, Stop Hunger Now rebranded to become Rise Against Hunger. After enlisting as a U.S. Marine during the Vietnam War, Ray Buchanan quickly recognised that accomplishing a mission required “commitments to something larger than yourself”

Driving Rise Against Hunger's work is the recognition that ending hunger is more than just feeding people, which led Rise Against Hunger to focus its feeding programme in areas where we can have a real impact and expand its hunger-fighting programmes beyond meal packaging and distribution.


### SUPPORT OUR MEAL PACKAGING EVENT

Rotary Club of Sandbach is planning a Meal Packaging event on 10th May 2020 at Sandbach High School and Sixth Form College, Middlewich Road, Sandbach. Our intention is to package over 60,000 meals.

Rise Against Hunger meal packaging events are a great way to make a difference. Each event provides a hands-on, international service opportunity for Rotarians, the community and youth.



The packaged meals are distributed by Rise Against Hunger's in-country partners around the globe through schools to encourage increased enrolment and attendance. For adults in community empowerment programmes, the provision of meals offsets productive time lost while attending training sessions. Meals distributed in hospitals and clinics may support patients' nutritional needs and complement their treatment



### VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers are one of the essential resources needed to help realise the vision of a world without hunger. Our target is to package over 60,000 meals. We need volunteers and donations to help us to achieve this target.
